Dear Parent/Carer

Welcome to Burwell Village College. We are really happy that you have chosen our school and recognise what an important decision this is for parents. We are a school that believes in the highest standards and expectations for ourselves and our pupils at the same time as wanting children to enjoy their time at school developing good social, communication and academic skills.

The school has been through a series of changes in the past few years, including a fantastic new building housing twelve of our classrooms and a linked bespoke Reception provision. The children have access to two school halls, a large outdoor space specifically for Reception, a large school field, playgrounds, astro turf and a sports hall.

We would like to invite you to an information evening regarding the school and Reception. This will be a chance for us to share with you some curriculum information, some basic school requirements and give you a tour of the school if you have not managed to see it in person already. We hope this will also give you a chance to ask any questions you have about the school and Reception in particular.

Thursday 13th June 2024 9.30 a.m. – 11.00 a.m. or 13.15 p.m. – 14.45 p.m. Class Visit

You will be offered either a morning or an afternoon time for your child to attend the school and meet with the staff. This will be very informal and give children a chance to explore the classrooms and meet some of the children they will be in a class with. Wherever possible, we ask that parents leave children as soon as possible, preferably just dropping them off with their teacher.

You will be offered a time to meet with the teaching team to share information about your child. This will mean that we can ensure there are activities and resources available that will interest your child from their first day. We can also discuss existing friendships, interests or concerns and ensure that the transition into school is as smooth as possible.
