## Sports Day – Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025

We are delighted to be able to invite you to your child's Sports Day this year.

As in previous years, there will be three phases to this year's Sports Day:

- Reception and Key Stage 1 Sports Day
- Whole school races
- Key Stage 2 Sports Day

Parents are invited to come along for their child's Sport Day session and stay for a whole school picnic lunch on the field.

The timings are as follows:

- Reception and Key Stage 1 – 9.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. – Reception and Key Stage 1 parents invited
- Whole school races – 10.10 a.m. to 11.50 a.m. – All parents invited
- Lunch – 12 p.m. to 1 p.m. – All parents invited
- Key Stage 2 – 1.20 p.m. to 3.00 p.m. – Key Stage 2 parents invited

### Arrival and Departure Timings

If your child is in Reception and Key Stage 1, please arrive at 8.50 a.m. and leave by 1.00 p.m.

If your child is in Key Stage 2, please arrive at 10.00 a.m. and leave by 3.00 p.m.

If you have children in Reception, Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2, you will arrive at 8.50 a.m. and leave at 3.00 p.m.

### Lunch

We will be having a whole school picnic lunch on the field, so children will need a packed lunch for this day. If you would like a school packed lunch or are in receipt of Free School Meals, please book online by accessing your child's Scopay account – go to the 14<sup>th</sup> July 2025 and click on a sandwich choice. The deadline for ordering a lunch is **Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025**. Hot lunches will not be available on this day

### Houses

As usual, the children will be in different houses for Sports Day. These will be shared with you via your child's class dojo by the end of the month. House colours for Sports Day are:

- Air – white
- Water – blue
- Fire – red
- Earth – green

Children need to wear a t-shirt that is predominantly their house colour alongside their regular P.E. kit (black shorts, black or white trainers).

Please make sure your child has sun cream applied in the morning. Children need to bring hats and water bottles, which they will have with them throughout the day.
