We would like to thank all three teachers for being part of our school. They have all contributed to the school's success and they have brought something unique to Burwell. We wish them all the best in the future in whatever they choose to do.

We have run a successful recruitment campaign this term and appointed two really strong teachers. Mrs Stacey Elbrow has run a successful childcare business for children with complex needs before training to teach. She will be joining us from October half term and will teach Miss Williamson's current class.

As Dr O'Neill is leaving us at half term, we felt it was important that her class had a teacher that they knew and could work well with before their new teacher starts with us in January. Therefore, Miss Williamson will teach Dr O'Neill's class until Christmas. After Christmas we are delighted that Miss Fatima Djemai will be joining us. She will bring a lot of joy and energy to the classroom along with high expectations of attainment and behaviour.
