**Year 1 – Educational Study Visit to South Angle Farm Park – Soham**  
**Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2024**

We have arranged for an exciting educational trip for all Year 1 children to visit South Angle Farm Park, Soham on **Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> March 2024**. This is to coincide with our theme – Animals including Humans. The coach will leave school at **9.00 a.m.** We will return around **2.00 p.m.** based on traffic.

The visit is a desirable part of our work, giving first-hand experience outside the classroom and an opportunity to apply what we will have learnt.

Children will all need to wear school uniform. Please could you also send your child with two drinks in a backpack or a clearly named bag (No fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). Also we would be grateful if you could send your child with a raincoat in their bag. All children will be provided with a school packed lunch. If your child wants to bring a home packed lunch, please contact the office to let us know by **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024**.

The Education Act requires us to ask you to contribute voluntarily to the cost of this visit, rather than charge you directly for it. The details of the costs are set out below. Any family in receipt of Family Credit, or where circumstances make full payment difficult, should contact the office, in confidence, as it may be possible to seek assistance from charitable funds. Any such assistance is provided anonymously. If you would like to make your contribution on a weekly basis please notify the office and a payment card will be provided. Please make your contribution for this trip online for the amount shown below by **Friday 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024** and also indicate online your permission for your child to attend.

We would be grateful for any parent helpers to come along for the day and help us. Please log onto your child's Scopay account and tick the permission box and tick the parent helpers box if you would like to help, by **no later than Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> February 2024**. If the school has not contacted you by **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> February 2024**, your assistance has not been required this time, but we thank you for your offer.
