Year 6 Educational Study Trip - PGL Caythorpe Court Adventure Centre - April 2025

Dear Parents/Carers

A provisional booking for the following dates has been made at PGL Caythorpe Court in Lincolnshire from Tuesday 1st to Friday 4th April 2025 for Year 6 as a whole group.

The Centre provides activities based on all areas of the National Curriculum, developing team building and social skills. All activity sessions are led by well trained, enthusiastic instructors and are specially designed to motivate, build confidence and encourage development in pupils.

It has high standards of health and safety covering all aspects of the centre. You can find out more information from the PGL website. To provide you and your child with more information about the trip, we would like to invite you to a parents' information meeting on Tuesday 11th June 2024 at 3.45 pm in the main hall. The session is designed to inform you about our residential trip in general and answer any questions that you may have. We would expect the meeting to last for approximately 30 minutes.

This cost this year is £370 per child which pays for the educational costs for the activities whilst at the centre, accommodation and all meals.

As a school we know that the residential trip is something important for our children and therefore we want to ensure that every child is able to attend. To this end, we are funding the cost of the transport this year. This is in recognition of the rising cost of living and increases to petrol charges etc. and will be reviewed annually to support all parents and most importantly pupils.

Please pay the non-refundable deposit payment of £100 by Friday 5th July 2024 via our online system and also indicate online your permission for your child to attend. The remaining payments of £270 can be made in instalments, either weekly, monthly, or paid as a lump sum. These instalments can also be paid via our online payment system with final payment due by no later than **Monday 3rd February 2025**.

The school is able to offer some financial assistance to families where circumstances make full payment difficult. Please be aware however that the school has a limited budget which will be shared equally amongst pupils who require such assistance. Any assistance is provided anonymously. Please speak to Mrs Taylor, School Business Manager in the first instance.
