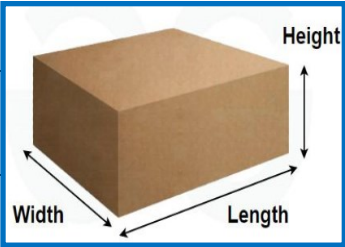




Sculpture - Picasso Inspired Faces

Key Vocabulary	
sculpture	A sculpture is a three-dimensional piece of artwork.
sculptor	A sculptor is an artist who makes sculptures.
3D	A three-dimensional (3D) shape has length, width and height.
length	Length is the distance from one end to the other.
width	Width is the distance across something, from side to side.
height	Height is the distance from the bottom to the top of something.
materials	A material is what an object is made from.
technique	A technique is the particular way of doing something.



Pablo Picasso

Pablo Picasso was a Spanish artist, who spent most of his life in France.



A lot of his artwork is in the cubist style. Cubist art shows objects or people from lots of different angles. It makes the artwork look as if it is broken up.



Sculptors make their ideas come to life by joining materials together.



Some sculptures can be viewed from all sides. Other sculptures are attached to a background and can not be viewed from the back.
