
# Listening and Appreciating – Peter and the Wolf

## Sergei Prokofiev



The story and the music for "Peter and the Wolf" was written by Sergei Prokofiev in 1936 for a children's theatre in Moscow, Russia. He used instruments from four instrument families to tell the story: strings, woodwinds, brass and percussion. The musical piece "Peter and the Wolf" has become one of Prokofiev's most important work.
