Ensemble

An ensemble is a group of people who work or perform together.



Melody

The melody is the tune.

It's the part of the music you often sing along with.

Tempo

The tempo is the speed of the music. It is how fast of slow the pulse is.



Dynamics



Forte means loud.



Piano means soft/quiet.

Verses usually come before a chorus. They often repeat but with different lyrics for each verse.

The chorus is usually a catchy section repeated throughout the song.

storm inside


Couldn't keep it in, heaven knows I tried
