An ensemble is a group of people who work or perform together.




Dynamics

f **Forte** means loud.

p **Piano** means soft/quiet.

Verses usually come before a chorus. They often repeat but with different lyrics for each verse.

The chorus is usually a catchy section repeated throughout the song.

Melody

The melody is the tune. It's the part of the music you often sing along with.


Pitch

The pitch of a sound is how high or low the sound is.




Tempo

The tempo is the speed of the music. It is how fast or slow the pulse is.



Pulse

The beat that runs through the music, similar to a heartbeat or the tick-tock of a clock.
