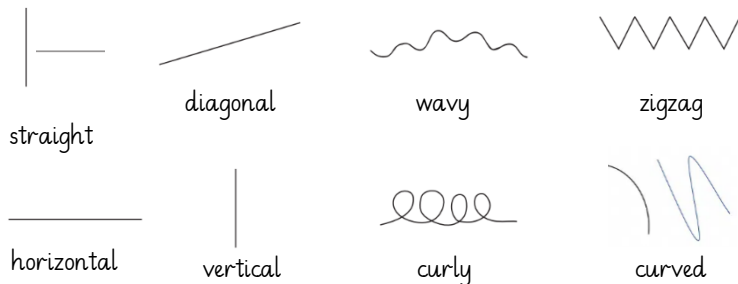




## Drawing - Continuous Line

Key vocabulary	Definition
vertical line	a straight up and straight down line
horizontal line	a straight line that moves from left to right
straight line	a line with no curvature
curved line	a line that is not straight and is bent
geometric shapes	shapes that have straight lines, points and curves
free form shapes	irregular shapes
tone	how light or dark a colour is
proportion	the relationship in size between two objects
continuous	unbroken, drawn without lifting the pencil

### Paul Klee

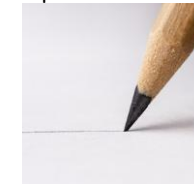
Paul Klee (1879 – 1940) as a German artist known for his individual style. In his **continuous** line drawings, he used:

- shapes
- lines
- pencils or charcoal

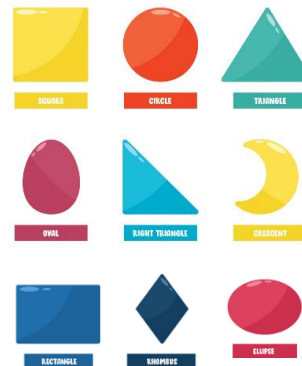
You can create **tone** by controlling the pressure of the pencil on paper.



**Sharp pencils** create crisp, clean lines. **Blunt pencils** create thick, bold lines.

### Proportion

We use **proportion** in drawings to make sure things look the right size compared to each other.

Example: If you draw a dog, the head should not be bigger than the whole body.
