

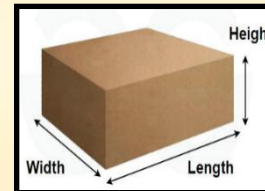


Sculpture – Paper Sculptures

Key Vocabulary

sculpture	a three-dimensional piece of artwork
sculptor	an artist who makes sculptures
3D	a three-dimensional (3D) shape has length, width and height.
length	the distance from one end to the other
width	the distance across something, from side to side
height	the distance from the bottom to the top of something
materials	what an object is made from
technique	the particular way of doing something

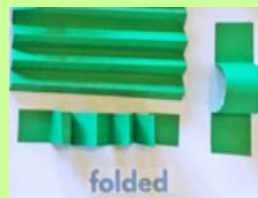
