Sculpture

Sculpture is an artistic form in which materials are worked into three-dimensional objects.

When creating a sculpture, it is important for an artist to think about the mass, space and form.

In order to do this, frames are used to provide support before a range of materials are added to the piece.

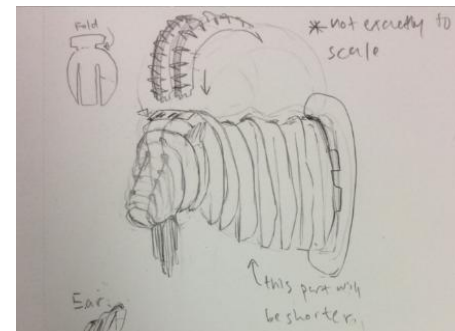
