video	a moving picture with sound
director	the person in charge of making the video
producer	the person who ensures the a video or movie is finished
dip	a short piece of video
timeline	a line where you put all your clips in the right order to make a movie
cut	when you split a video into two parts
transition	a special way to go from one clip to another (like fading or sliding)
tri m	to make a dip shorter by cutting off the beginning or end
soundtrack	music added to the video
voiceover	when someone talks over the video to explain or tell a story
export	converting a project into the final video file
green screen	a special background you can change into anything (like space or the ocean)
