



## Vocabulary

<b>video</b>	a moving picture with sound
<b>director</b>	the person in charge of making the video
<b>producer</b>	the person who ensures the a video or movie is finished
<b>clip</b>	a short piece of video
<b>timeline</b>	a line where you put all your clips in the right order to make a movie
<b>cut</b>	when you split a video into two parts
<b>transition</b>	a special way to go from one clip to another (like fading or sliding)
<b>trim</b>	to make a clip shorter by cutting off the beginning or end
<b>soundtrack</b>	music added to the video
<b>voiceover</b>	when someone talks over the video to explain or tell a story
<b>export</b>	converting a project into the final video file
<b>green screen</b>	a special background you can change into anything (like space or the ocean)

## What is Video Editing?

Video editing is the process of altering and arranging clips to create a final video. This can include altering the sound and adding images.

- advertising (short videos to encourage you to buy something or go to a specific place)
