Digestive organs and their functions

Mouth/Teeth — teeth cut and chew food into smaller pieces

Oesophagus - a stretchy tube that carries swallowed food to the stomach

Stomach — a bag where food is mixed with acid and broken down more


Small Intestine — takes nutrients from food into the blood

Large Intestine — takes water from food and makes waste

Anus — where waste (faeces) leaves the body

Types of teeth and their functions

Incisors — sharp and flat, used for cutting food

Canines - pointed, used for tearing food

Premolars — flat, used for crushing food

Molars — large and flat, used for grinding food
